1. Do I have to have an account to view regulatory hearings?

You do not have to be a GovLink user to view regulatory hearings. You do, however, have to have an account to be able to comment on proposed rules.

2. What do the statuses within GovLink mean?

- **Awaiting Hearing**- A hearing date is upcoming but the comment section has been closed.
- **Comment Period**- Proposed rules are open for public comment.
- **Complete**- The hearing has taken place.
- **Pending**- A hearing date has not been scheduled.
- **Scheduled**- A hearing date has been set but comments are not open yet.

3. Is my comment anonymous?

Yes, but you have the option to sign your comment. You also must have a GovLink account to leave a comment.

4. How can I view my comment after I have posted?

GovLink users may view and download their comment after posting by selecting the dropdown menu beside the title "Public Comments: [Proposed Rule Name]."
